We have seen the response drafted by the ABI which we support fully. A change in the law to make those with pleural plaques some form of special case will lead to unintended consequences. A very powerful House of Lords concluded that no damage is caused by pleural plaques and no risk of future damage exists and thus to award compensation is just not appropriate or necessary."
