- Covers role of registered persons.
- Contains glossary.
- Written by a professional writer.
- Guidance Advisory Group represents broad range of sectors.

# Protecting Vulnerable Groups Scheme

## CHECK TO PROTECT

- PVG Scheme procedure similar to Police Act.
- Application completed.
- Form signed and submitted.
- Fee will be paid.
- Disclosure Scotland respond.

# Protecting Vulnerable Groups Scheme

## CHECK TO PROTECT

- Registered persons have a role in PVG Scheme.
- Police Act requires Scottish Ministers issue a Code of Practice.

- **What the guidance is not.**
- Not a detailed explanation of Parts 1 and 2 of the PVG Act.
- Not a set of desk instructions.

- **What the guidance is.**
- Overview of Parts 1 and 2 of PVG Act in everyday language.
- Illustrates the main touch points.
