We do not have any particular pieces of legislation that are requesting for inclusion, hence the reason why I haven't used for the form, but would like to ask if you could give consideration to a list of three additional points that we have?

AFS response:

Alcohol Focus Scotland request consideration be given to the following:

- *add "enlisting, procuring, aiding and abetting" etc to the proposed offences*
- *the list of primary offences to include exclusions for any person convicted of money laundering;*
- *the exclusion of any person who has been declared an unfit person to be a director of a company under the Companies Act legislation.*

Otherwise, we think draft is a very comprehensive list of relevant offences and support the document.
