

Thank you for your response to my email.

My husband and I would be grateful if Mr Butler could pass on to the relevant authority our deep concern about the proposals contained in the Householder Permitted Development Rights Consultation Paper which we have read in its entirety. We wish to object *in the strongest possible terms* to the whole concept of relaxation of planning controls.

Even with the controls currently in place extensions are being built which are not in keeping with the original buildings, and to allow relaxation of the sort being suggested would inevitably lead to extensions and alterations which would bring detriment to the built environment, not to mention disputes and distress to neighbours.
