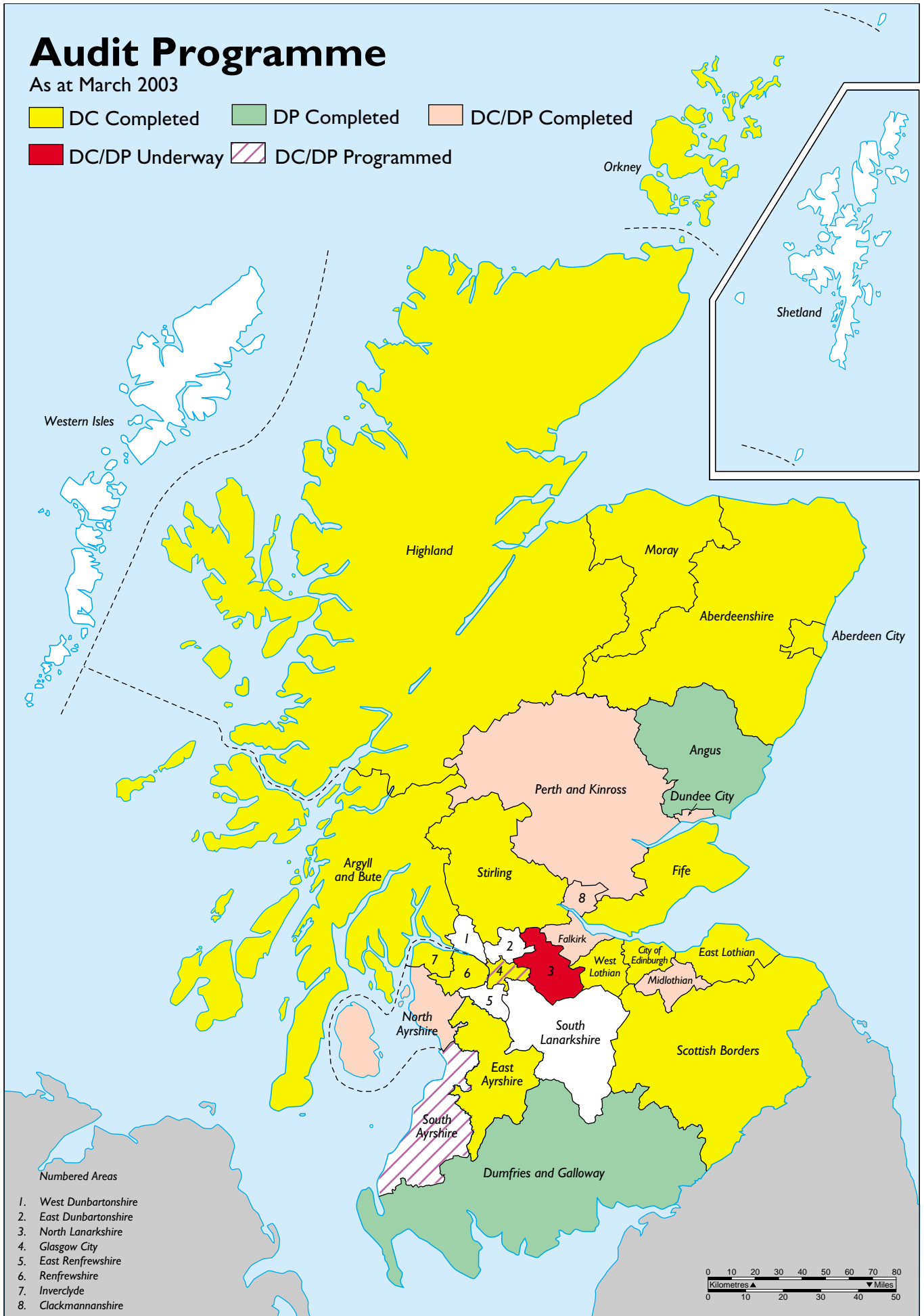
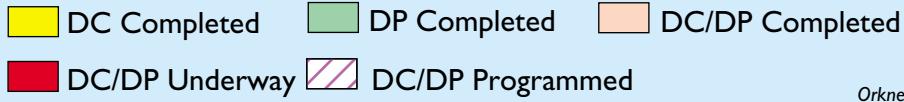
THE PLANNING AUDIT UNIT

The Planning Audit Unit

The Planning Audit Unit was formed in 1996 to review councils' development control performance, to work with individual councils to identify best practice and areas where improvements could be made to the processes and services. The audits were later extended to cover development planning. Two thirds of Scottish councils have now had a planning audit. The map overleaf shows Audit coverage to date and proposals for the coming year.

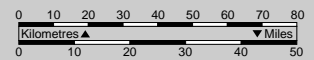
Audit Programme

8. Clackmannanshire



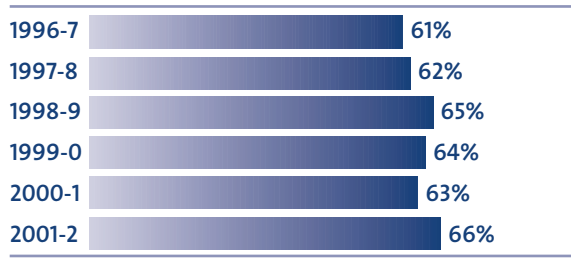
PLANNING AUTHORITY
PERFORMANCE

Planning Authority Performance

All Applications:

Overall performance has improved in the face of a significant rise in planning applications. The number of applications handled in Scotland annually has reached 47,312, 10% up on last year. Three councils, Moray, North Lanarkshire and East Dunbartonshire, experienced increases of 20% and more.

Previous years have seen a fairly consistent average of 41,000 - 42,000 applications across Scotland. The increased numbers appear to be mainly for householder, minor residential and other minor development, while there has been a decline in advertisement applications.



Despite this increase in the number of applications, 66% were determined within 2 months compared with 61% five years earlier. Performance continues to fluctuate seasonally, with summer highs (67%) and winter lows (64%).

The wide variation in performance between councils reflects local circumstances and practices. Since April 2001, 18 authorities have improved their performance. Clackmannanshire and Fife reached or exceeded the 80% target. Some, like Shetland, are showing a decline. Only two councils have two-month performance levels lower than 55%, Glasgow City and North Lanarkshire. Both are being covered by present or planned audits.

The target of determining 85% of applications in three months has been met or exceeded by Angus, Clackmannanshire, Dundee City, East Dunbartonshire, East Lothian, East Renfrewshire, Fife, Inverclyde, Moray, Orkney, Perth and Kinross, Renfrewshire, Scottish Borders, West Lothian and the Western Isles. The lowest rate was 71% whereas last year's lowest was 66%. This is a significant improvement.

Householder

An improvement of 3% over the previous year against a target of deciding 90% of householder applications in two months was recorded in 2001/2002. Nine councils met the 90% target: Aberdeenshire, Argyll and Bute, Clackmannanshire, Falkirk, Fife, Inverclyde, Moray, Perth & Kinross and South Lanarkshire.

The target for determining householder applications in three months is 95%. Returns to March 2002 show 16 councils achieving this, three more than the previous year. The Scottish average is now 94%, an improvement on last year's average. No council had a 3 month householder performance of less than 88%.

Minerals

There are relatively few minerals applications. During the period, authorities determined 74 applications relating to mineral extraction. 20% of these were decided within the two months and 34% within three months. There has been no change in this trend in the past two periods. The remaining 66% of the 74 applications determined took longer than 3 months to reach a decision. Many applications for mineral extraction are accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment and raise complex issues. Some are locally controversial. For these reasons they tend to take longer to

deal with. Within the period, 15 of the 32 authorities did not determine any mineral applications.

Conservation

In this period, there were 3,647 applications for listed building or conservation area consent, about 7.5% of the total caseload. Although improvements have been made in recent years, on average only 37% of applications for listed building and conservation area consent are determined in two months and 66% in three months. Although these figures remain low, they show a gradual improvement over previous years.

Section 75 Agreements

The last two six-monthly returns show that decisions associated with Planning Agreements increased by more than 10% over the year and now run at around 200 a year. There are very big differences between authorities. Aberdeenshire continues to record the highest number of agreements.

Enforcement

Planning authorities have the discretionary powers to take formal enforcement action where it appears there has been a breach of planning control. Powers are fully described and explained in [PAN 54: Planning Enforcement](#), published in 1999.

In the year October 2001 to September 2002, 6,838 cases were investigated and 918 notices issued. Enforcement cases often begin with complaints to planning authorities about alleged unauthorised development, or activities that cause nuisance to neighbours. Notices issued are Planning Contravention Notices, Enforcement Notices, Breach of Condition Notices and Stop Notices.

There is wide variation between authorities in the numbers of cases taken up and notices served. Over Scotland as a whole the rate of notices served to cases taken up is 13.4%. In Dundee City, East Ayrshire, Fife, Glasgow City and West Dunbartonshire the rate is over 30%, while in East Dunbartonshire, Shetland and West Lothian it is less than 5%. East Lothian and Moray councils issued no notices.

Development Plan Departures:

Applications advertised as potential departures increased from 1,458 to 1,621 in the reporting year, matching the overall increase in applications for the year. The rate of approved departures has changed little over the years and now stands at 14 in every 1000 applications. As in earlier years there are big variations between authorities.

Aberdeenshire, Dundee City, East Ayrshire and South Lanarkshire all recorded over 35 per 1000 applications, though no council had more than 40. Seven councils recorded no approved departures.

Development Plan Coverage

Returns to the Executive show a decline in the coverage of adopted up-to-date plans (adopted in the last five years) from around 40% in September 2001 to around 34% in September 2002. This fall is mainly due to local plans in Aberdeenshire and Angus becoming more than five years old. If the finalised local plans now coming forward across Scotland are included, the position appears more positive, improving from around 62% in September 2001 to 74% in September 2002. All these figures express coverage in population rather than area terms.

Telecommunications

Planning authorities have been asked to submit separate statistics on applications for telecoms developments since the introduction of the new planning controls in July 2001. Research has now been commissioned to evaluate the effect of the new controls.

The figures for 2002 show that the number of telecoms applications received by planning authorities steadily dropped from a high of 310 in the first quarter to just over 200 in the third and fourth quarters. Levels remain highest in the cities where rollout of third generation networks and capacity improvements in second generation networks are focussed.

During the third quarter of 2002 the number of applications determined was higher than the number received. This is a positive change and suggests that the backlog from 2001 is now clearing. Performance against the 2-month target has improved from 33% determined within 2 months during the first quarter of 2002 to over 50% within 2 months in the last 2 quarters of the year. However, there are a number of councils with consistently poor performance where improvement is required. Telecoms application statistics for the period October to December 2002 will be included in the next report.

Scottish Executive Performance

Structure Plans

Scottish Ministers aim to approve structure plans within 40 weeks of submission, unless an EIP is necessary. Performance in processing submitted plans to approval against the 40-

week target leaves considerable room for improvement, although in some cases the delay in approval was as a result of legal challenge. The target is clearly demanding yet the intention remains to try to reach it whenever possible. Most recently, the Dundee and Angus plan was successfully determined in 36 weeks.

Casework Performance

In the period April 2001 - March 2002, 92% of cases notified to Scottish Ministers were determined within 28 days against a target of 80%, while 98% were determined within two months against a target of 100%. Since 1997/98 the Executive has improved its performance against both targets.

In the same period the percentage of decisions on inquiry cases made within two and three months of receipt of report from Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit (SEIRU) was 75% against a target of 80% and 81% against a target of 100% respectively.

Scottish Ministers Involvement in Planning Cases

The table opposite sets out the number of planning decisions made in each local authority and the level of Scottish Executive involvement (the number of notified applications, Notice of Intention to Develop cases and recalled appeals). Since the number of cases annually is fairly small, the figures are given for the period April 1996 to March 2002. Ministers' involvement in casework is very limited in all parts of the country compared to the total number of decisions made by councils.

The table opposite shows notified cases. Over the period April 1996 - March 2002, 976 cases were notified to the Scottish Ministers. During that period 190 (19%) were called-in and a decision to refuse was made in 83 (9%). Glasgow and North Lanarkshire Councils had the highest number of notified applications, while Highland Council had the highest number called-in and refused, most were trunk road referrals.

FINDINGS FROM THIS YEAR'S AUDIT

Findings from this Year's Audits

This year three full audits were carried out by the Planning Audit Unit, examining the whole planning service in Midlothian, Clackmannanshire and North Lanarkshire. Although the last of these audits has yet to report formally, the main conclusions from all three can be summarised here. On development control, one of the Councils (Clackmannanshire) operated a service which has consistently met Scottish Executive targets for time taken. But all three audits addressed points for action in relation to customer care and information, staff morale and training, and the wider use of new technology. Here are some of the points made.

Development Control

- Improve information and service at the front counter
- Seek faster response to customer enquiries.
- Record pre-application discussions
- Speed up registration
- Tell applicants immediately if applications are invalid
- Send out consultations in parallel immediately on registration
- Inform consultees of decisions made
- Properly record site visits
- Review delegation arrangements to improve speed and quality
- Aim for factual yet concise reports
- Keep proper records of the basis for decisions even on minor cases
- Give due attention to enforcement and proactively monitor conditions

Development Planning

- Use development control experience in reviewing plans
- Improve the plans' focus on delivery
- Ensure staff resources are available to do the job in good time
- Allow adequate time and resources for document preparation
- Expand policies in development briefs
- Set out the targets and milestones the plan intends to achieve
- Monitor progress on preparation and implementation
- Ensure proper exchange of information before and during a Local Plan Inquiry
- Negotiate any modifications well before the Inquiry starts

Development on the Ground

- With patience, tenacity, lateral thinking, and an ability to inspire others, imaginative outcomes can be got from limited resources
- Use all the tools in the toolbox - be pragmatic.
- Make the most of external funding by working with developers, and with agencies like SNH, SEPA and Historic Scotland
- Local Heritage Trusts can be a vehicle for drawing in funding and encouraging community involvement in environmental projects.
- Long-term vision joins up opportunities over time.
- Put good developments, initiatives and service improvements forward for awards.
- Recognising achievements raises everyone's game and brings even more positive possibilities within reach.

Points for the Scottish Executive

In audits this year, these key points were made by service users, councillors and staff.

Legislation

- Legislation and regulations, especially the General Permitted Development Order, are difficult to understand and should be simplified and consolidated. - *Sometimes it is hard to simplify legislation without reducing its effectiveness. We will make every effort to ease understanding when the next changes are made, and will publish a consolidated GPDO as soon as other priorities permit.*
- The 1984 Advertisement Regulations need updating, particularly in relation to new banner adverts. - *The need for updating is accepted but it is unlikely to proceed short term because of competing priorities.*

Guidance and Advice

- The Executive should encourage pre-application discussions - *Scottish Planning Policy 1: The Planning System and PAN 40: Development Control give clear guidance and advice on their importance. The Clackmannanshire audit showed these discussions are valued by planners and developers alike, and reflect in excellent development control performance figures.*
- The Executive should encourage greater involvement with economic development. - *SPP 2: Economic Development underlines how planning should relate to the economy, promote sites for economic development in sustainable locations, and calls for more effective dialogue between planners and the business community.*
- The Executive should give clearer guidance on affordable housing issues. - *SPP 3: Land for Housing addresses affordable housing issues.*
- There should be more guidance on developer contributions, particularly for the funding of large-scale infrastructure across local authority areas. - *A recent conference on Planning Agreements promoted by the Executive and others re-emphasised the guidance established in Circular 12/1996.*
- Guidance on Tree Preservation Orders and landscaping would be helpful. - *The Executive published research in October 2002.*
- There should be more advice on design. - *Designing Places published in 2001 has now been followed by PAN 65: Open Space and PAN 67: Housing Quality. A PAN on Design Statements will be published shortly.*

Development Control

- The Executive should create standard application forms. - *Getting Involved in Planning proposed standard planning application forms for Scotland and received wide support. The forthcoming White Paper will indicate the Executive's intentions.*
- Some building warrant applications are submitted online, a similar service should be possible for planning. - *The Executive and local authorities are examining these issues through an e-planning group, with a view to removing barriers to electronic service.*
- More clarity is needed on the Executive's role in call-in cases. - *SPP1: The Planning System sets this out.*
- Review of neighbour notification procedures is required. - *The Executive is addressing this: proposals were canvassed in Getting Involved in Planning. The forthcoming White Paper will indicate the Executive's intentions.*
- The planning application fee structure is too complicated and fees for householders should be reduced; retrospective applications discredit the system and should carry a higher fee. *The Executive is looking to commission research on fees shortly.*

Development Planning

- The process needs to be reviewed and streamlined. Brevity is sought yet extra factors are identified nationally for councils to include. There are conflicts between advice on style and detail and the needs of development control, and between public consultation and faster plan-making. *Pilot projects with South Lanarkshire and Highland Councils are in progress, and we will shortly engage with stakeholders on the modernising agenda.*
- The time the Executive takes to approve structure plans holds everything back. *Following the Review of Strategic Planning the Executive signalled a new approach, with city region plans to focus on key issues and quicker preparation and approval.*
- Local plan inquiries need attention; it is very difficult for individuals and community groups to get involved. - *Following Getting Involved in Planning, the Executive intends to consult shortly on modernising Public Local Inquiries.*
