POSITION STATEMENT FOR WEST DUNBARTONSHIRE

As you are aware, the CVS and Volunteer Centre in West Dunbartonshire are already integrated.

As requested, an exchange of letters is currently taking place between WDCVS and West Dunbartonshire Community Planning Partnership to acknowledge the CVS's move to direct Third Sector Funding and intimate Community Planning Partnership endorsement of that process. Reporting: Peer Review/Turning the Tables

WDCVS currently monitors and evaluates its work based on an outcome and economic impact focussed model across both its volunteering and sector support services.

The prospect of a single reporting format such as that suggested in the 'Turning the Tables' report would be very much welcomed as a means to streamline reporting and ensure that it is targeted and meaningful across the CPP. The opportunity to develop peer review opportunities is also welcomed.
