IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SWINE FLU VACCINATION

The UK departments of health have launched the swine flu vaccination programme.

The vaccine is being offered to people who are most likely to become seriously ill if they catch swine flu. These priority groups are made up of adults and children over six months of age who:

- Have a serious health condition such as chronic lung, heart, kidney, liver or neurological disease, or diabetes mellitus
- Are pregnant
- Have an immune system that is compromised because of a disease or treatment for a disease
- Live in the same house as someone whose immune system is compromised because of a disease or treatment for a disease

If you are in one of these priority groups you may be invited to go to a vaccination clinic or to make an appointment at your surgery. Not everyone in the country will get their vaccine at exactly the same time, so don't worry if you are not contacted straightaway.

If you are not in any of the priority groups listed you may be offered the vaccine at a later stage – but for now, the priority is to vaccinate those who are most at risk.
