**Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of  
3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not  
intended for human consumption**

**The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003**

**Approval of incinerators**

In accordance with regulation 14 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 12 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (as read with Commission Decision 2003/327/EC) the Scottish Ministers approve as incinerators—

- (a) all incinerators approved to incinerate specified risk material under the TSE (Scotland) Regulations 2002;
- (b) incineration plants which comply with the requirements of Annex IV to Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002; and
- (c) all low capacity incinerators which were in operation on 1 November 2002 and which are not used to incinerate specified risk material or whole carcasses containing specified risk material.

For each premises this approval ceases to apply either when those premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 October 2003.
