Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not intended for human consumption

The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003

Approval of storage plants

In accordance with regulation 14 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 11 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 the Scottish Ministers approve as Category 1, 2 or 3 (as the case may be) storage plants any premises which were on 30 September 2003 storing processed products derived from that Category of animal by-product.

It is a condition of approval that premises must apply to the Scottish Executive Environment and Rural Affairs Department for continued approval before 1 January 2004, and failure to do so shall invalidate this approval.

For each premises this approval ceases to apply either when those premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 October 2003.
