**Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not intended for human consumption**

**The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003**

**Approval of oleochemical plants**

In accordance with regulation 14 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 14 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (as read with Commission Decision 2003/326/EC) the Scottish Ministers approve as oleochemical plants any premises which were on 30 September 2003 processing rendered fats derived from Category 2 and/or Category 3 material.

This approval ceases to apply either when the premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 October 2003.
