intended for human consumption**

The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003

Approval of the use of animal by-products for feeding to recognised packs of hounds

In accordance with Regulations 25 and 26 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 23 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 the Scottish Ministers authorise the use of animal by-products for feeding to recognised packs of hounds currently registered under the Animal By-Products Order 1999.

For each premises this approval ceases to apply either when those premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 October 2003.
