**Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of
3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not
intended for human consumption**

The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003

Approval of the use of animal by-products for feeding to dogs from recognised kennels

In accordance with Regulations 25 and 26 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 23 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 the Scottish Ministers authorise the use of animal by-products for feeding to dogs from recognised kennels.

It is a condition of approval that the operator of the kennels must apply to the Scottish Executive Environment and Rural Affairs Department for continued approval before 1 January 2004, and failure to do so shall invalidate this approval.

For each premises this approval ceases to apply either when those premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 July 2003.
