**Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of
3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not
intended for human consumption**

The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003

Approval of operators who collect, treat or mix used cooking oils for use in animal feed

In accordance with Schedule 4, Part III to the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 1 of Commission Decision 2003/320/EC the Scottish Ministers approve those collectors and operators on the list maintained by the Product Authentication Inspectorate as -

- (a) collectors of used cooking oil; and
- (b) operators of premises on which used cooking oil is treated or mixed with other oils.

Conditions of approval

1. The collector or operator must have been carrying out the operation on 1 November 2002.
2. The name of the collector or operator must appear on the list maintained by the Product Authentication Inspectorate on 1 November 2002 and 30 September 2003.
3. The collector or operator must continue to have his name on the list maintained by the Product Authentication Inspectorate. If the collector or operator has his name removed from the list he is no longer approved under this approval, and must apply to the Scottish Ministers for individual approval.

This approval operates from 1 October and expires on 1 November 2004.
