



Sheep & Goat Identification and Tracing System

Farm Register

A holding register must be kept for each permanent holding you keep sheep or goats at. The register must be kept for 3 years and requires the following information:

- the number of sheep/goats on the holding at 1st January each year.
- all on & off movements recorded within 36 hours.
- details of the haulier & vehicle registration used.
- a market lot number if purchased from a market.
- a record of replacement ear tags applied.
- deaths, although not a requirement under ID & trace legislation, is a requirement under Animal Health & Welfare legislation. It would be sensible therefore to record animal deaths in this record.

UK Tagging

- All sheep/goats must have a unique individual numbered identity before they leave a holding.
- You must only use ear tags from approved manufacturers.
- Animals born after 18/01/2008 must be tagged with two identical UK holding of birth tags within 9 months of age or before they leave their holding of birth.
- Older animals tagged with a UK or S baseline tag do not need further tagging.
- Older animals never tagged require to be double UK tagged when leaving the holding they are on.

Slaughter Derogation

- Animals born after 18/01/2008 can be single UK tagged with a holding of birth tag if they are intended for domestic slaughter within 12 months of age.

Replacement Tagging

- Non homebred animals that lose a UK tag must be retagged with the same flock mark & individual number (if known) or with a red replacement tag bearing the flock mark of the holding they were on when the tag was lost. Homebred animals can be retagged with another UK Tag.

Movement Documents

- Each movement between a different holding (CPH*) requires a movement document (unless exempt). * County/Parish/Holding
- Movements must be reported to SAMU within 3 days by the receiving keeper.
- You must retain your copy of the movement document for 3 years.
- Record the actual location of animals on the document. Do not use 7000 code numbers where a non 7000 number already exists for the holding.
