ORDER FORM FOR BLUETONGUE (BTV8) VACCINE

The Scottish Bluetongue Vaccination Campaign commences on 3 November 2008. Vaccination is compulsory for cattle and sheep and strongly encouraged for other susceptible animals.

This form is for use by livestock keepers to order BTV8 vaccine from their veterinary practice. You may only order vaccine through one practice. Vaccine for **immediate** use only should be ordered.

I, being the keeper/owner of the animals identified overleaf, understand that:

- bluetongue vaccine can only be used in accordance with the regulations and general licences set under The Bluetongue (Scotland) Order 2008,
- I am only entitled to order vaccine for immediate administration to animals under my care which are resident in Scotland,
- bluetongue vaccine **must be refrigerated** between +2°C and +8°C during any storage period and any vaccine which fails to be suitably stored must be destroyed,
- once opened, bottles of vaccine should be used within 8 hours, and must be refrigerated during this time,
- no return of unused vaccine can be accepted.
