


What's been delivered so far?

- 2016**
 - A Blueprint for Fairness published in March
 - Scottish Government accept CoWA targets in May
 - Commissioner for Fair Access appointed in December
- 2017**
 - Care Experienced Bursary of £7,625 introduced in April [rec 22]
 - Access Delivery Group established in August
 - Report on Widening Access published in September [rec 30]
 - Commissioner publishes 1st annual report in December [rec 1]
- 2018**
 - National Articulation Forum established in March
 - Care Experienced Bursary increased to £8,100 in April
- 2019**
 - Publication of the new National Articulation Database in April
 - Launch of the Framework for Fair Access in May [rec 2]
 - Access thresholds published for entry to all HEI's for 2020/21 in Spring [rec 11]

In 2017/18 15.6% of Scottish full time first degree entrants to Scottish universities were from the 20% most deprived areas. Only 0.4 percentage points away from the Widening Access Commission's interim target for 2021.
