







Figure 2: Sexual Orientation by Age - Scotland 2015




The LGBO group was much **YOUNGEr** than the heterosexual group.


3 in 10 LGBO adults were aged 16-24








MySSCQ Example – General Health



Multiyear Statistics on Smoking Prevalence

Multiyear Scottish Survey Core Questions (MySSCQ) pools survey data across multiple years, providing sufficient sample to analyse smoking prevalence at electoral ward, and Scottish- and UK-parliament constituency levels.

(Note that the Scottish Health Survey remains the source of the National Performance Framework indicator)



The data have been sorted into coloured groups, each of a similar size. Hover over any area for details.




